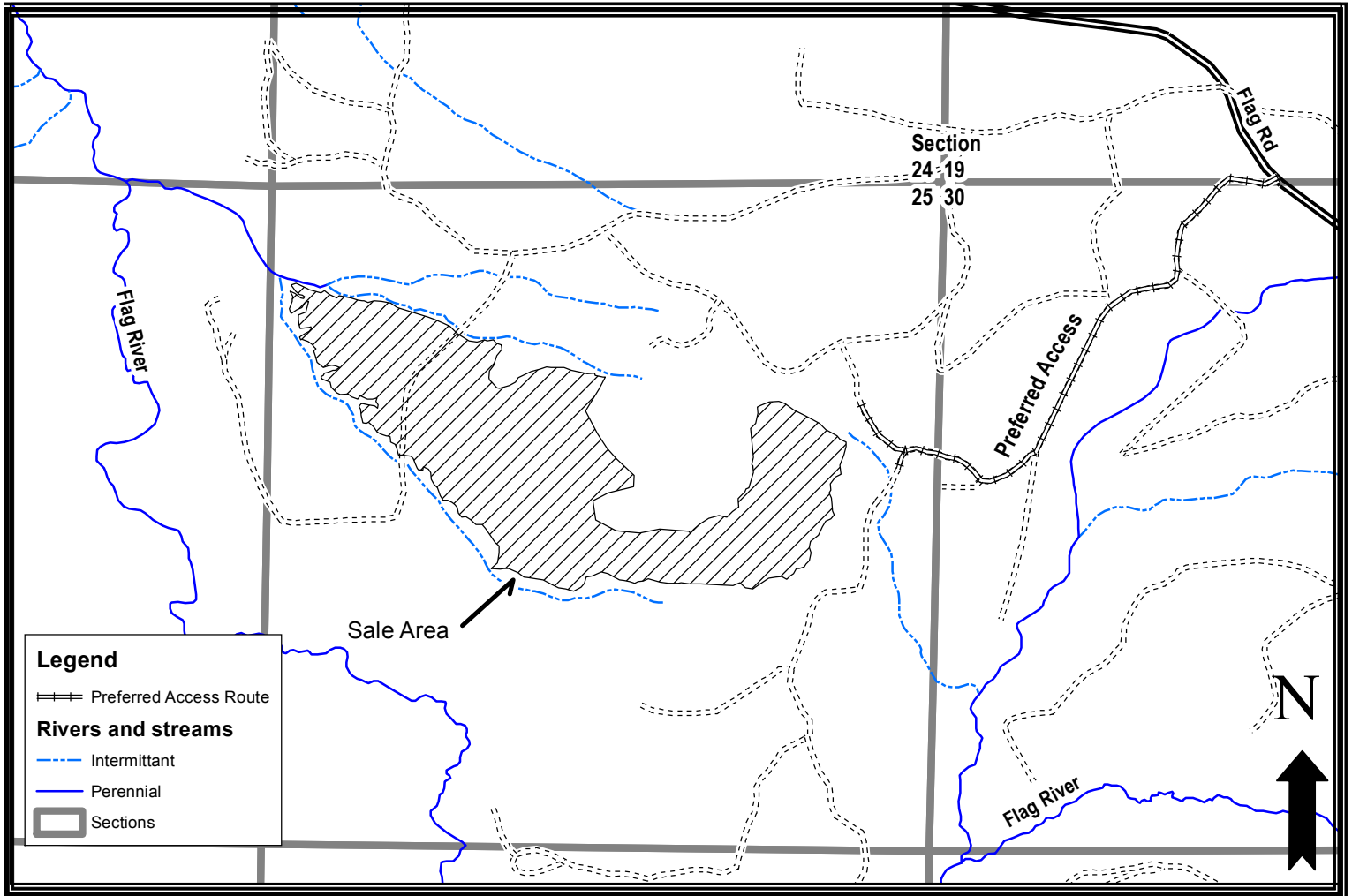

Harvest requirements:

- This is a ticket sale to be harvested in dry or frozen season only, as determined by Bayfield County.
- Culverts or pole fords will be required on non-navigable drainages in three or more places on the Preferred Access route. Follow BMPs for water quality for all drainage crossings.
- If the sale will be whole-tree harvested, leave one in ten tops scattered in the sale area.
- Do not cut snags except those that pose a safety hazard to logging operations.
- LEAVE all oak 14" dbh and greater, and LEAVE all pine and spruce.
- CUT all oak LESS THAN 14" dbh, all merchantable fir greater than 4" diameter, and all other trees 2" dbh and greater.
- Do not damage any survey monumentation.
- Flag Rd is a snowmobile and ATV trail. The purchaser must ensure that harvest and hauling operations will not create a safety hazard to snowmobiles or ATVs. If harvesting occurs during winter, snowmobile trail must be kept unobstructed and in a packed-snow condition.
- Prior to moving equipment on to or off the sale area, scrape or brush debris and soil from exterior surfaces.
- This contract requires county authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission of Bayfield County.
