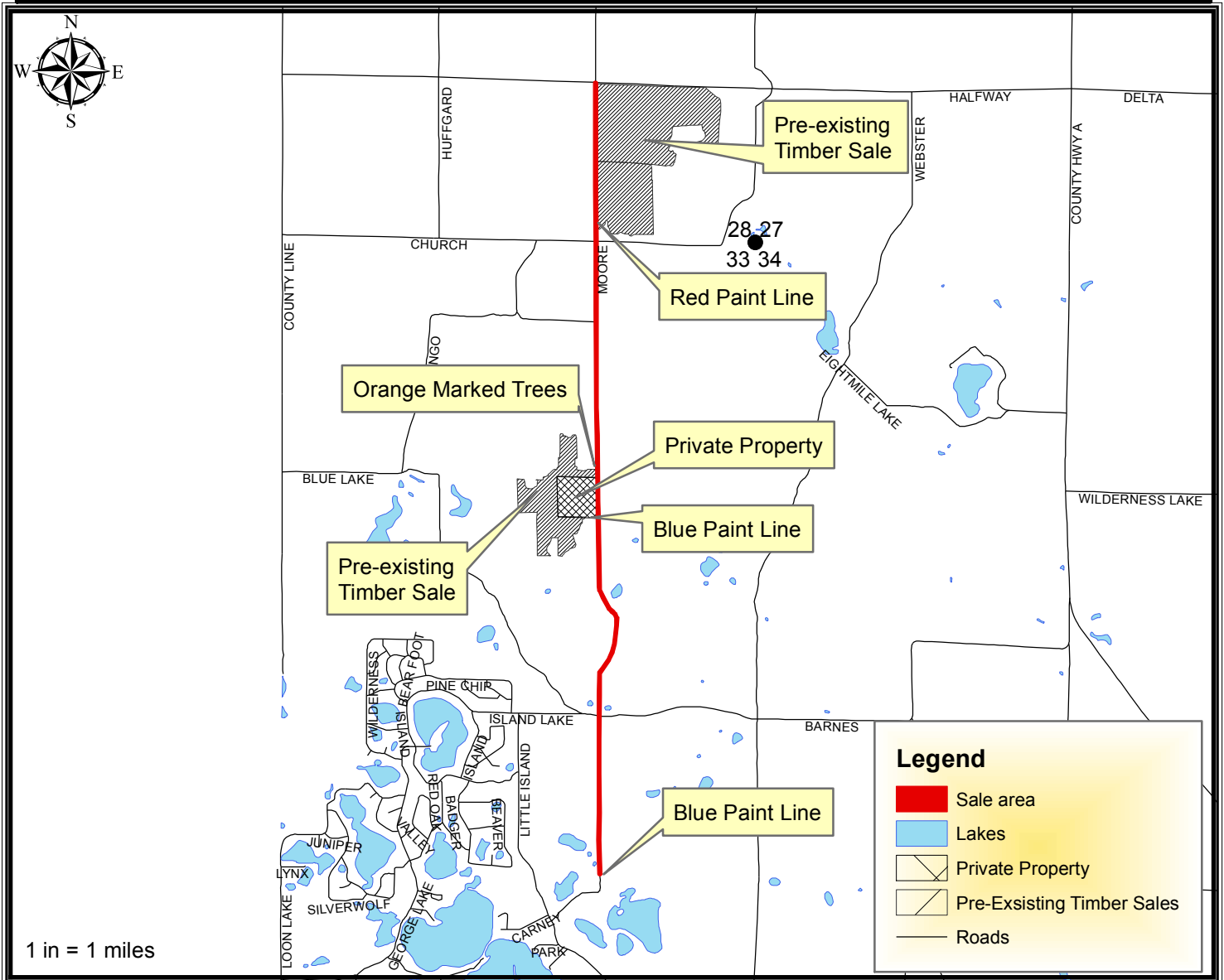

**Harvest Requirements:**

- Sale is a clearcut being sold on a Ticket Scale Basis.
- Sale must be finished by May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2014
- The harvest is defined as 50 feet from the edge of the road surface of Moore Road on both sides, starting at the intersection of Moore Road and Halfway Road heading south to the edge of Bayfield County property.
- Harvest all merchantable trees and sever all trees 1" in diameter and greater within the sale area.
- Do not cut trees on privately owned land. The private/county boundaries are marked with blue paint.
- Do not harvest trees on pre-existing timber sales. The boundaries are marked with red paint.
- Do not cut any orange marked trees because they are part of an existing timber sale.
- The purchaser must ensure that harvesting and hauling operations will not create a safety hazard for traffic on Moore Rd.
- To comply with the Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off of the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
