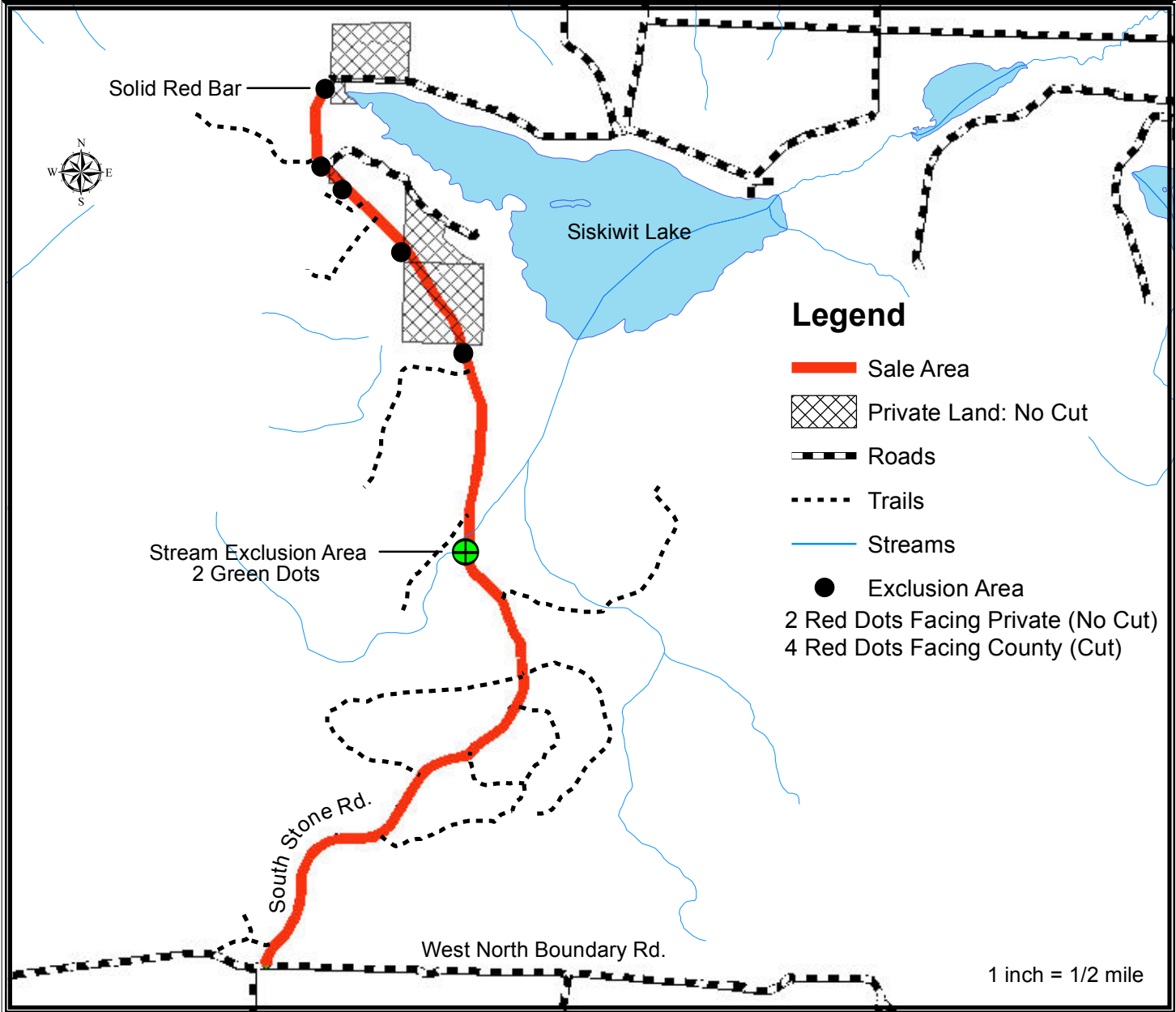

Harvest Requirements:

- Whole tree harvesting is required.
- The harvest area is defined as 15 feet from the edge of the maintained (graded) road surface of South Stone Road, starting at the intersection of S. Stone Rd. and West North Boundary Rd and heading north.
- Harvest all merchantable stems and sever all trees 1" in diameter and larger within this 15 foot zone.
- Do not cut trees on privately owned land. The private/county boundaries are marked with two red dots facing private and 4 red dots facing county.
- Do not cut trees in the stream exclusion area that is marked with 2 green dots.
- The purchaser must ensure that the harvesting and hauling operations will not create a safety hazard for traffic (ATVs included) on South Stone Rd.
