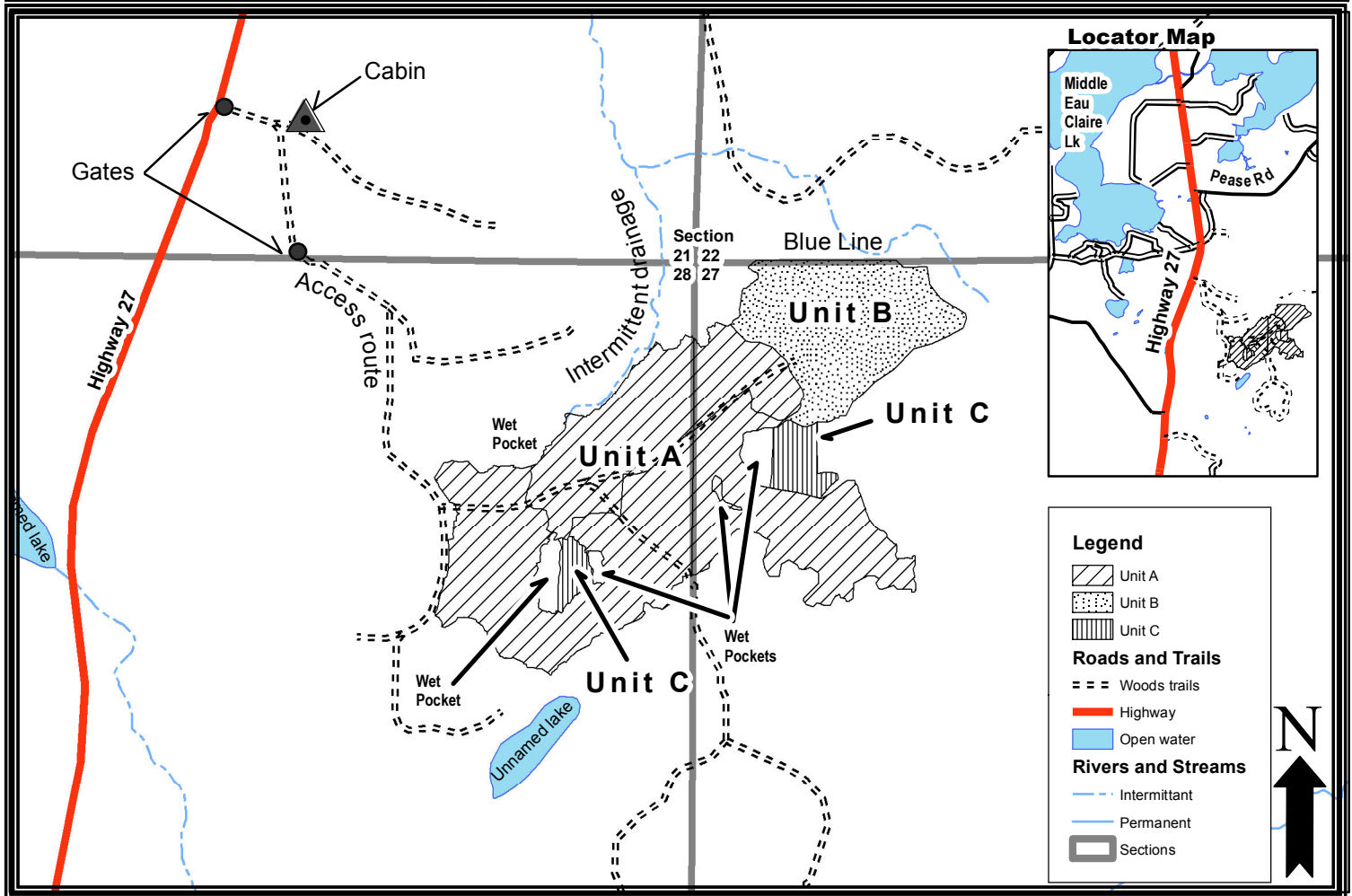

*Mixed Hwd approx.. 60% hard maple, 25% soft maple, 10% basswood, and 5% white birch.
 **Tamarack approx.. 70% tamarack, 10% fir and 20% black spruce.



Harvest requirements:

- This is a ticket sale. Access through private land has been obtained by Bayfield County Forestry Dept.
- External boundaries marked in red paint. Property line marked in blue paint. Internal boundaries marked in red (Unit A and B) and green (Unit C).
- Whole-tree harvesting is allowed. Whole-tree skidding is not allowed in Unit B, unless contractor can demonstrate it can be done without damage to residual stand.
- **Unit A (overstory removal and shelterwood):** LEAVE all purple-marked hardwoods. LEAVE all painted and unpainted yellow birch, and all painted and unpainted hemlock. LEAVE all un-painted pine, unpainted white spruce. LEAVE all cedar. CUT purple-marked pine and CUT purple-marked white spruce. CUT all other trees 2" dbh and greater, including CUT all balsam fir two sticks and larger.
- **Unit B (NH Selection):** CUT all orange-marked trees. Ignore orange paint on aspen, CUT all aspen. Do not damage residual trees. **No sale operations permitted in this unit between breakup and July 15th.**
- **Unit C (lowland conifer strip clearcut):** CUT all trees 2" diameter and greater, except LEAVE all hemlock, cedar, and white pine. **Harvest Unit C only during frozen ground conditions.**
- There are numerous pockets of ash scattered throughout the sale. Harvesting is allowed in these areas only during frozen-ground conditions.
- Do not damage any survey monumentation.
- Prior to moving equipment on to or off the sale area, scrape or brush debris and soil from exterior surfaces.
- Do not cut snags of other species except those that pose a safety hazard to logging operations.
- This contract requires county authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
