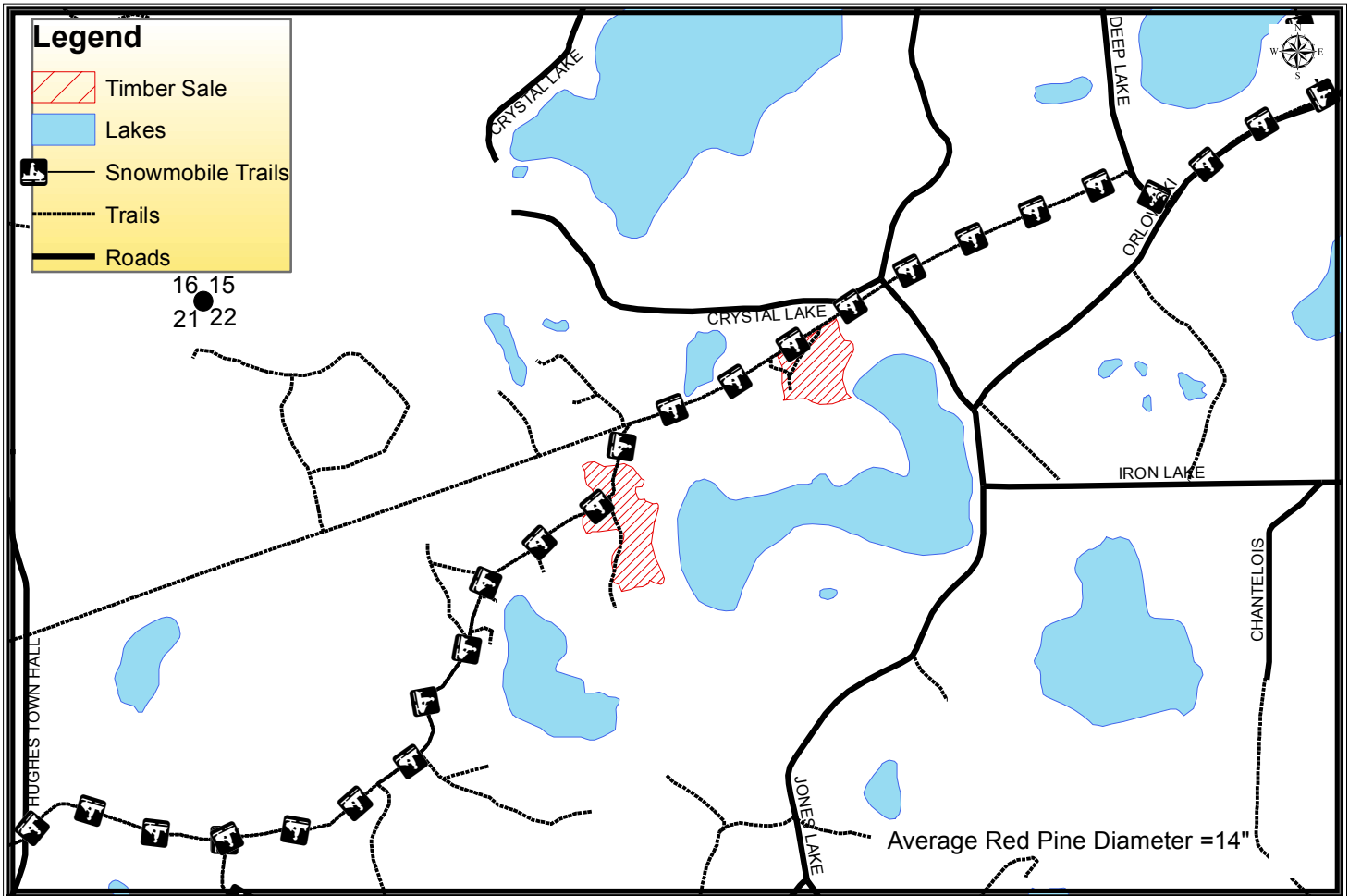

## Harvest Requirements:

- Sale is a marked red pine thinning being sold on a Ticket Scale Basis.
- Harvest all orange marked trees.
- Sale boundaries are designated by trails or noticeable timber type changes.
- Harvested pine cannot be kept on the Bayfield County Forest for more than three weeks from May 1<sup>st</sup> to August 31<sup>st</sup>.
- Damage to residual stand must be minimized.
- Do not cut snags except for those that pose a safety hazard.
- Signage must be used along the Snowmobile/ATV trail. During winter harvesting the snowmobile trail must be kept unobstructed and in a packed snow condition. The purchaser must insure that harvesting and hauling operations will not create a safety hazard to snowmobiles.
- Whole tree harvesting and/or utilization of tops less than 4" diameter will not be allowed.
- The contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
- To comply with the Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off of the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.

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
