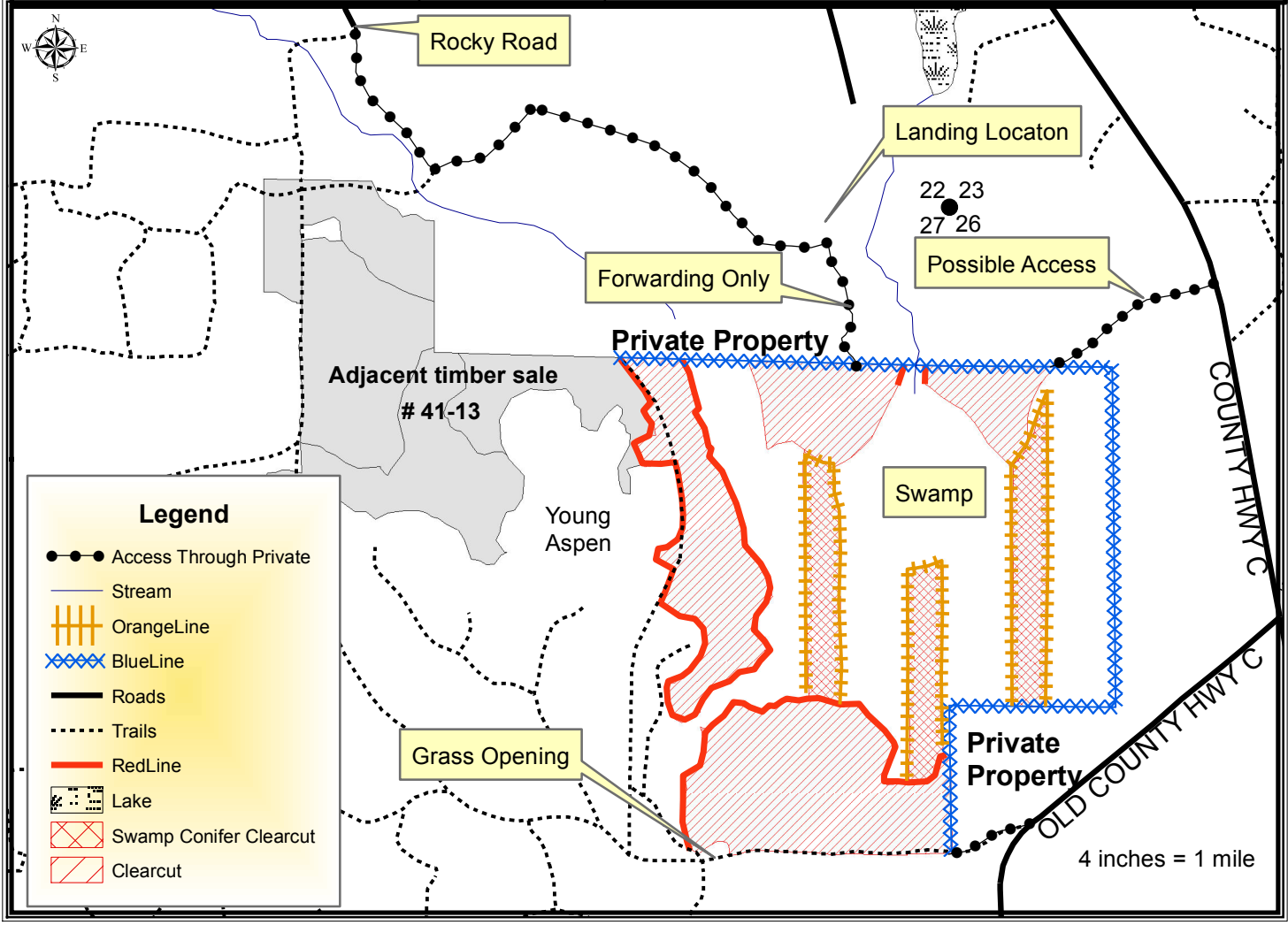

**Harvest Requirements:**

- Sale is a clearcut being sold on a Ticket Scale Basis.
- Sale boundaries consist of red paint, orange paint, blue paint, trails, or abrupt change in timber type.
- Clearcut Unit: Harvest all merchantable jack pine, balsam fir, spruce and orange marked red and white pine. Leave all hemlock, cedar, and unmarked red and white pine. Harvest all merchantable hardwood except orange marked oak, birch, and maple. Sever all non-merchantable hardwood stems 2" in diameter and greater.
- Swamp Conifer Clearcut Unit: Harvest all merchantable stems except white pine, red pine, hemlock, and cedar. Sever all non-merchantable stems 2" in diameter and greater.
- Sale operations may only occur during frozen or dry ground conditions only, as determined by sale administrator.
- The blue paint line indicates private property, no equipment or trees may cross the blue line except at designated access points.
- Access through private property has been secured by Bayfield County and is indicated on the map.
- On a portion of the road through private property **only forwarding** to a designated landing will be allowed as noted on the map.
- Do not cut snags except for those that pose a safety hazard.
- To comply with the Best Management Practices for Invasive Species: Prior to moving equipment onto or off of the sale area, scrape or brush soil and debris from exterior surfaces to the extent practical.
- Decking of wood along town roads will not be allowed without permission from Bayfield County.
- If harvest will utilize the whole tree, 1 in 10 tops must be left scattered throughout the sale.
- This contract requires County authorization for all road/landing construction and places a number of other requirements on road construction and closure.
